**1. Course Objectives:** After the course, students will have English language skills in listening, speaking, reading, and writing, focusing on social studies terms and the structure of English commonly used in social studies from related print materials and others, and social studies terms and structure of English commonly used in instruction; applying knowledge in social studies instruction.



## Method of Teaching

- (8) Assign students to study important knowledge on their own.

- (2) From assignments that are given and not copied from others, with honesty and integrity.
- (3) From practicing responsibility in learning activities and group work.
- (4) From participating in learning activities, answering questions, and discussion
- (5) From observing in teaching and learning activities and the participation in the discussion.
- (6) From group work and presentation of discussion results
- (7) From mid-term and final-term academic achievement test
