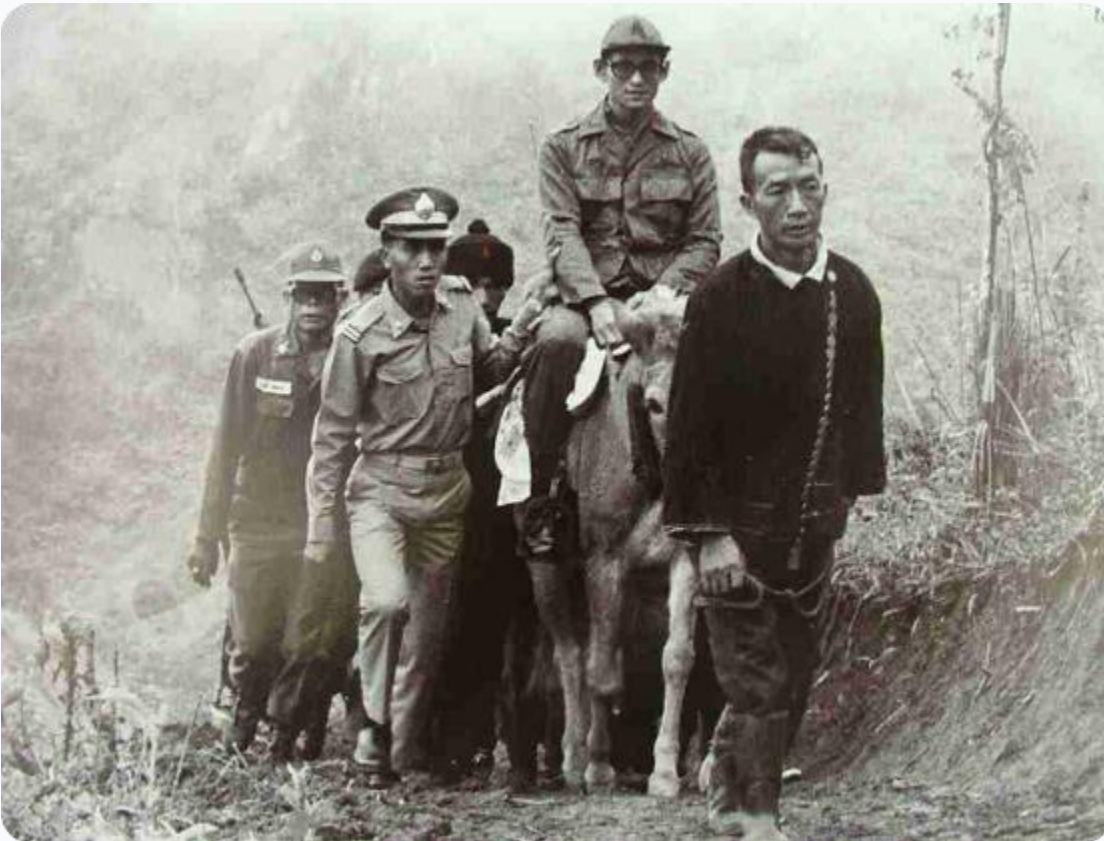

Balanced Modernization

- ✓ **Balanced growth:** Harmonizes local traditions with modern global forces.
- ✓ **Universal scope:** Applies to personal living and national governance alike.



Avoiding Extremes

- ✓ **Extreme thoughts:** Avoid reckless expansion and rigid isolation.
- ✓ **Extreme actions:** Prevent debt-driven overconsumption and waste.

The Three Pillars of Sufficiency

1

Moderation

Not too little, not too much. Living and spending strictly within one's true capacity.

"Permits luxury, provided it fits individual financial means."

2

Reasonableness

Justifying decisions based on legal, moral, and academic principles.

"Evaluating cause and effect before taking critical action."

3

Self-Immunity

Built-in resilience and risk management against unforeseen shocks.

"Preparing for fluid, dynamic global circumstances."

Two Essential Conditions



Knowledge Condition

Prerequisite for operational planning and practical implementation.

Comprehensive data: Utilizing thorough academic insight.

Careful planning: Applying technical accuracy at every step.



Ethics & Virtues Condition

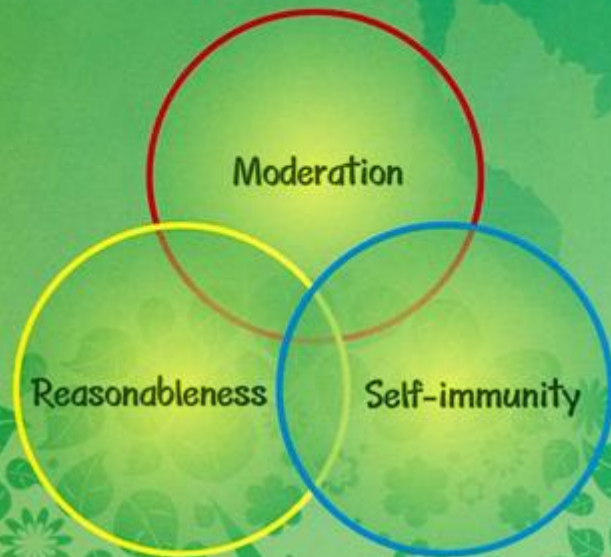
Moral foundation fostering long-term human and economic advancement.

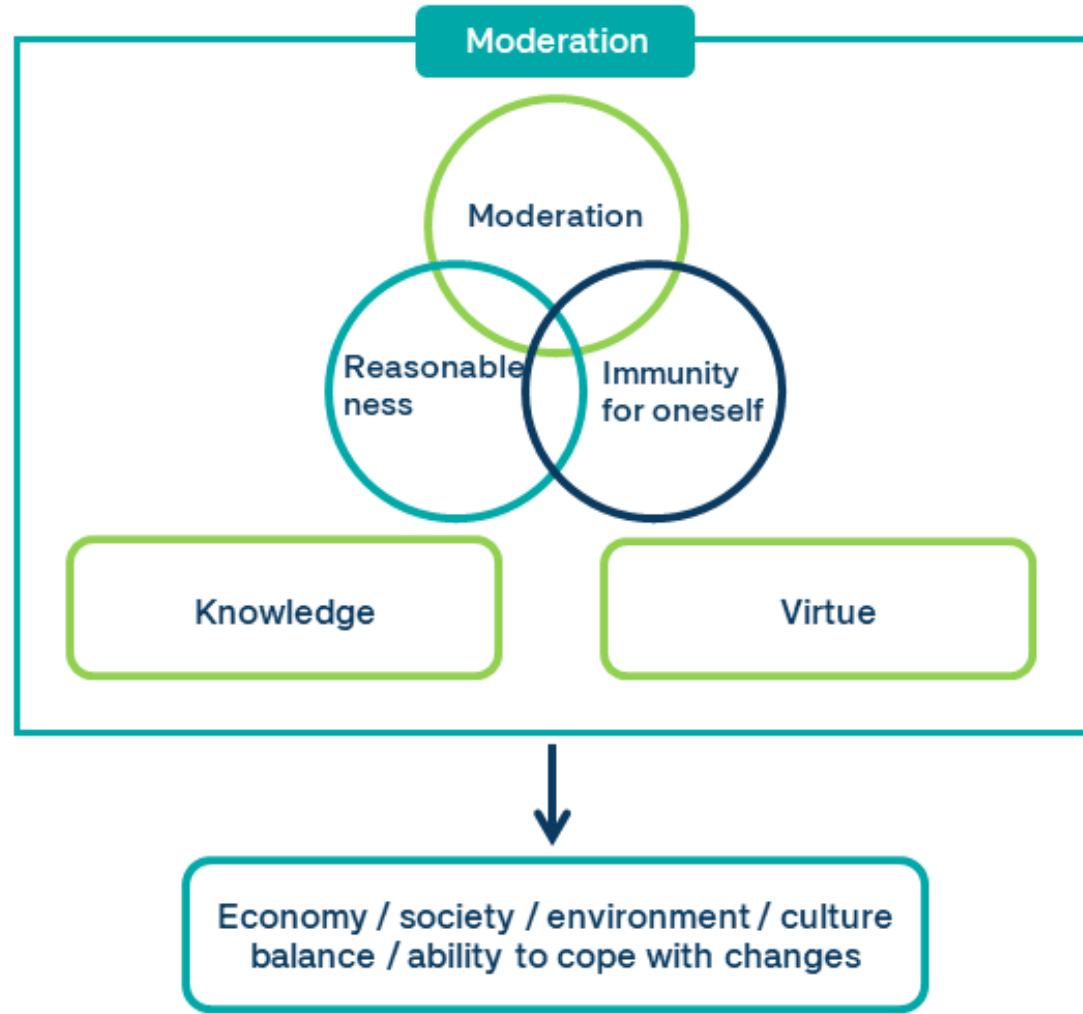

Four Dimensions of Self-Immunity

Material Immunity

Maintaining financial savings, risk insurance, and long-term future budgeting.

Social Immunity

Fostering unity, social contentment, and peaceful coexistence among people.

Environmental Immunity

Living in harmony with nature while preserving ecosystem health.

Cultural Immunity

Preserving local heritage while valuing diverse global perspectives.

Foundation-Building in Stages

STAGE 01 • PRIMARY STEP

Secure Basic Subsistence

Ensure majority population has adequate food and income using economical, correct methods.



STAGE 02 • ADVANCED STEP

Expand Growth & Prosperity

Gradually scale economic standards once a stable base is established.

Human Development Advancement

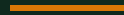
Elevates individual well-being while strengthening the collective community resilience.
